## **Training – Statement of Intent**

Lanchester Parish Council is committed to the development of its members and employees and values the contribution they make to providing quality services.

The Council will encourage members and employees to improve their own and others performance and will ensure equality of opportunity in development. The Council recognises that it is important that the right people with the right skills are able to perform to a high standard.

This training policy applies to all employees and members irrespective of contracted hours, grade or length of service.

Lanchester Parish Council recognises that successful training can take many forms which include; on the job training, in-house courses, external courses, distance learning courses, mentoring etc. The council will at all times seek to secure the most appropriate and cost effective delivery of training.

Training needs will be assessed annually through a training needs analysis form completed by members and employees, and through an annual performance review for employees. This information will form an annual training plan. This document will be flexible enough to allow for the introduction of other necessary training during the year.
